



## John Arthur Harmon

February 4, 1947 - December 24, 2021

John Harmon Sr. passed away on December 24, 2021 at home surrounded by family and friends. He was 74 years old.

John was born in Oakley, California in 1947 and attended Liberty Union High School. Right out of high school, John joined the U.S. Army and was a drill sergeant during the Vietnam War, until he was honorably discharged two years later. He moved to Madison, California and worked at the Concord Naval Weapons Station as a stevedore foreman. In 1998 he moved to Hermiston, Oregon where he finished out his career as an Explosive Operator leader and a Toxic Equipment Test Supervisor. He loved God, family, fishing and the San Francisco 49ers, and will be missed by all who knew him.

John was a foster parent for many years and adopted several children.
