John Martin Rider, a lifelong Siskiyou County resident, passed away peacefully after a long illness on July 22, 2024 at the age of 59.

Martin was born in Yreka on August 1, 1964 to John H. and Constance Rider. Martin is survived by his wife, Heather; son, Garret (Nonna) Rider; grandchildren, Cyrus and Sophia Rider; sisters, Brenda (Mike) Morris, Sheri (Rance) Rider, and brother, Nick (Michelle) Rider; aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, and dear friends.

He also loved shooting and spent many hours out on the ranch enjoying gun powder therapy.

Martin enjoyed fishing out on the ocean for Ling Cod and bottom fish, diving for abalone, and spent many days crabbing, digging clams, eeling on the rocks off the coast and surf fishing for perch.

He will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

Martin did not want formal services. A celebration of life will be held in the future.
