Longtime Yreka resident Joseph Campbell Whitsett passed away September 16, 2011 at Fairchild Medical Center in Yreka. He was 86 years old.

Joseph was born July 28, 1925 in Gold Beach, Oregon to Julian and Mabel Whitsett. He attended school in Gold Beach, and entered the U.S. Navy after graduating high school.
