camping, hunting, fishing, hiking, softball, family vacations, family reunions, and time spent at the "Family Cabin" in Butte Meadows.

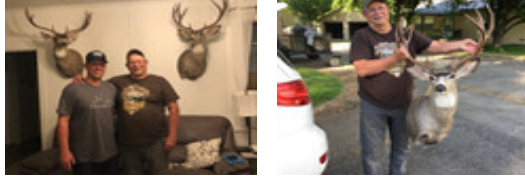
