Larry Lee Duff, 77 of Grenada, California was surrounded with family when he joined his parents in heaven on January 18, 2021.

Larry was born August 28, 1943 in, Decatur, Indiana to Fred and Gretchen Duff. He married the love of his life, Nancy, on December 22, 1968 in Monrovia, California.
