Lloyd Richard Elliott, the Founder and Director of The Siskiyou Chorale and former music professor at College of the Siskiyous in Weed, passed away on Friday, August 5, 2016 in Mt. Shasta, losing his battle with cancer. He was born September 8 in Seattle, Wash. to Lloyd and Charlon Elliott. He graduated high school from Sequoia High School in Redwood City, CA and received his Bachelor's degree from San Francisco State. He finished his Master's degree from University of the Pacific in Stockton, CA.

Music was Lloyd's passion. He studied choral conducting under Robert Shaw, Helmut Rilling, Elmer Thomas, Eric Erickson, Dale Warland and Robert Fountain. He formerly conducted the Modesto Master Singers, Berkeley Chamber Singers, Merced Masterworks Chorus, Santa Rosa Symphonic Chorus and was guest conductor of the Stockton Chorale. He was the former conductor of the Community College Orchestra at the College of the Siskiyous, as well as the instructor of Music Theory.

Lloyd is survived by his partner, Laura Barrett; his four children, Deirdre Elliott (Matthew Lewis), Ethana Elliott, Dion Elliott (Jillita) and Nathaniel Elliott; a brother, Scott Elliott; a grandson, Michael Leshar; two great granddaughters, Emma and Gracie Leshar and a nephew, Josh Elliott.
