She enjoyed being outside fishing, hunting, riding horses, and traveling. Her other hobbies included leather craft, stain glass work, sewing, needle point, and knitting. She always had numerous pets and enjoyed their company.

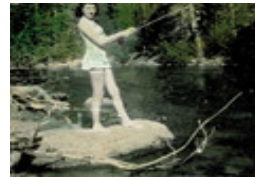
