August 30, 1918 - January 18, 2015

Quartz Valley resident Louise Bare, 96, passed away Jan. 18, 2015, at Fairchild Medical Center in Yreka following a brief illness.

Louise was born in Topeka, Kansas, on Aug. 30, 1918, to Edward and Hazel Camp. She met the love of her life, Warren Bare, while serving as a USO volunteer at a U.S. Army hospital in Topeka.

Louise and Warren were married on Aug. 30, 1944. They moved to San Diego, California, in 1955, so that Warren, a national champion bicycle racer, could practice year-round.

They made their home outside of Ramona, California, where they created the Bar E Pony Ranch.

Louise had a long and successful career with Union Bank of San Diego. After Warren died in 2008, Louise made her home in Siskiyou County with her niece, Jean (Terry) Weathers and family in Quartz Valley, where she enjoyed watching sports, reading, attending theater and spending time with family.

She was preceded in death by her sisters, Mabel Lake and Betty Bohnenblust.
