comfort is that she has relief from her pain and is safe in the arms of Jesus.

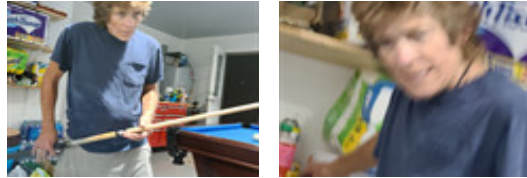
She is survived by her mother, Gerrie Froiland; daughter, Kara (Jesse) Peck; five grandchildren; and a brother, Andy Froiland.
