



## Lyda N. Teasley

May 27, 1931 - March 18, 2021

Lifelong Siskiyou County resident Lyda N. Teasley passed away on March 18, 2021 at Madrone Hospice in Yreka. She was 89 years old.

Lyda was born in Yreka on May 27, 1931 to Warren and Irene Nelson. She was raised in Fort Jones, and was working as a "soda jerk" when she met Granvil Teasley, who had come in for a chocolate milkshake. They became friends, and were married on January 22, 1950. Lyda and Granvil moved to Yreka and raised a family. Lyda was both a Girl Scout Leader and a Boy Scout Leader for her kids. She later was a teacher's aide at Gold Street School, then a clerk at Rasco. Lyda was best known for working at the court house as a printer. She was a member of the Methodist Church, Daughters of the Nile, and was very active in the Order of the Eastern Star. Lyda enjoyed doing crafts, and enjoyed collecting porcelain dolls.

Lyda is survived by her children, Granvil Teasley, Marjorie Dole and Patricia Callahan; two brothers, Robert and Edward Nelson, six grandchildren, twelve great grandchildren and three great-great grandchildren. Lyda was preceded in death by her husband, Granvil, in 1990.
