Manuel (Manny) Pacheco, born February 18th 1925, has passed away peacefully from natural causes at the age of 96. Manny proudly served his country in the US Navy on the USS Ajax during World War II and the Korean War. Manny was known to be a caring, resilient, and supportive man.

As a dedicated Moose Lodge member in Santa Rosa, California, Manny could frequently be found behind the bar or perched atop a barstool.
