89 year old Marguerita Hall passed away peacefully on February 11, 2020 at her home in Grenada, where she was a resident for 47 years.

Marguerita was a skilled knitter, whose products included sweaters, slippers, potholders, doilies, etc. When her arthritis started getting bad, she had the foresight to pre-knit and store all of the necessary items for future grandkids.

Marguerita was a big fan of Lawrence Welk and polka music, especially on Sundays, which were designated as house cleaning days. The overplaying of polka music may certainly have steered her children to different music tastes! She loved being a mother, and always devoted time to raising her kids and maintaining the house.

Marguerita was preceded in death by her husband, Wilson, in 2002, and by her parents. She is survived by her children, June (Blaine) Cook of Gazelle, Walter (Mona) of Montague, and Wilson (Chantel) of Fortuna; she is also

survived by 4 brothers: Albert, Pete, Tommy, and Donny Beltramo; there are also 8 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren surviving.

A graveside funeral service will be held on Friday, February 21, 2020 at 12 Noon at the Gazelle Cemetery in Gazelle, with a reception to follow.
