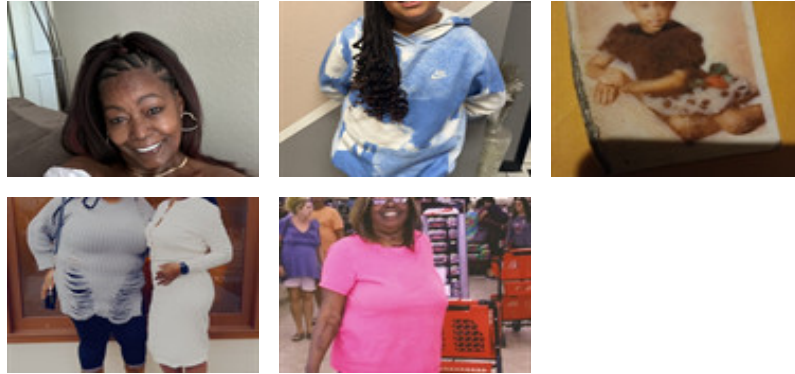
She will be laid to rest in Bloomington next to her beloved mother and father.
