Montgomery Shine Sophia Green, a 19 year old former resident of Etna, CA died tragically in an automobile accident near Crescent City, CA on April 14, 2016.

Montgomery was born in Seattle, WA, on February 17, 1997. After graduation, Monte was living and working in Grants Pass, OR, and registered to begin college with an interest in criminal psychology. She remained extremely close to her mother and brothers. Montgomery had a passion for music, was adventurous, and enjoyed cooking. She was a very talented, intelligent, compassionate, beautiful young woman taken from us too soon.

Montgomery is survived by her mother, Rebecca Green Stein, brothers Joseph and Roman Stein, and her grandfather, Ed Green and his wife, Susie, of Etna; her grandmother Sharon Fraga Hickey of Reedsport, OR; her father, sister and brother, Jason, Juniper and Koh Brand, and grandparents Jim and Janis Brand, all of Lake Tahoe, CA; and numerous uncles, aunts and cousins.
