



Morgan Richard Sisk

August 7, 1990 - April 4, 2021

Morgan Richard Sisk passed away April 4, 2021 due to injuries sustained in a traffic accident. He was 30 years old.

Morgan was born to Joe and Brenda Sisk on the seventh day of the eighth month of 1990 at Siskiyou General Hospital in Yreka. He attended Big Springs Elementary and Yreka High Schools. While in high school, Morgan worked at the Siskiyou County Museum during the summers with Mike Hendryx. He played football, ran track, and graduated in 2008. Morgan attended College of the Siskiyous and was working toward a degree in Fire Science and Communications. He volunteered on the Lake Shastina Fire Department while attending COS.

After high school, Morgan worked for the U.S. Forest Service fighting fire out of Happy Camp, Quincy and most recently out of Mt. Shasta. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps for four years, and was stationed in North Carolina, Okinawa Japan, and back to North Carolina. Corporal Sisk was honorably discharged in August of 2019.

Morgan worked at Timber Products in Yreka pulling green chain during some of the off-seasons to earn a little money and stay in shape, and was a member of the Montague Volunteer Fire Department during that time. He was recently offered a permanent position with the U.S. Forest Service in Mount Shasta,

and was preparing to go back to work with them.

Morgan has left behind family and friends who will need time to comprehend, to come to grips with and to adjust to a very large hole left in their lives. He is survived by his parents, Joe and Brenda; an older brother, Matthew, his wife Danielle and their children; a sister, Megan; his best friend and girlfriend Ashley Tudor, and many friends and family members.

Services will be held at the Grenada Berean Church in Grenada on Saturday, April 17th, 2021 at 2:00 PM. There will be a procession to the Little Shasta Cemetery after the service for military honors, followed by a potluck at the Grenada Berean Church.
