



Narcy "Fae" McBain

January 20, 1919 - October 26, 2012

Lifelong Siskiyou County resident Narcy "Fae" McBain passed away October 26, 2012 in Ashland. She had been in failing health for some time. She was 93 years old.

Fae was born January 20, 1919 near Gottville to Stephen and Narcy Clyburn, the youngest of 9 children. She attended Honolulu School and graduated from Yreka High School. After high school, Fae attended beautician school in Marysville and worked as a beautician after graduation. In 1940, she married Ernest McBain. Fae served in the U.S. Army Air Corps as a Sergeant in the WAC's for two years during World War II, and was stationed in Florida. After the war, she worked for Cal Trans for 20 years. Fae was a life member of the American Legion, a longtime member of the Yreka United Methodist Church and a life member of the Siskiyou County Historical Society. She always maintained a beautiful flower garden at her home.

Fae is survived by her daughter, Narcie Alexander of Medford, two grandchildren, two great grandchildren and many nieces, nephews and cousins. She was preceded in death by her husband, Ernest McBain, in 1973, and her siblings, Stephen Clyburn, Henry Clyburn, Robert Clyburn, James Clyburn, Thomas Clyburn, Joseph Clyburn, Frances McMaster and Woodrow Clyburn.
