



Noble Phillip Tibbs

April 22, 1929 - July 12, 2015

Longtime Burney resident Noble Phillip Tibbs passed away July 12, 2015 in Burney. He was 86 years old.

Phil was born on April 22, 1929 in Yankton, South Dakota to Jesse and Myrtle Tibbs. He was raised in Scott Valley, and graduated from Fort Jones High School. He served two years in the U.S. Navy. After leaving the service, Phillip married Anna Buckley on September 29, 1950. Phillip worked a short time for the U.S. Forest Service prior to working for California Department of Forestry and Fire for over 40 years. The family lived in Southern California for most of his time with CDF before relocating to Northern California in 1968. Phil retired from the Burney CDF in 1988 as Captain. Phil loved guns, hunting, fishing, cars, sailing and his two dogs, Duke and Becky. He especially loved the forest and forestry.

Phil is survived by his daughter, Judy Logan of Paradise; a sister, Synthea Smith of Etna; eight grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his wife, Anna Tibbs, and two sons, DeWayne and Jeffery Tibbs.

A graveside service will be held on Saturday, July 18, 2015 at 11:00 AM at the Fort Jones Cemetery, where he will be laid to rest next to his wife.
