



## Patsy L. Obrikat

September 5, 1935 - January 2, 2021

Longtime Fort Jones resident, Patsy Obrikat, passed away on January 2, 2021 at her home at the age of 85.

Patsy was born Patsy Louann Craig to Norman and Beatrice Craig in Enid, Oklahoma. Patsy married her high school sweetheart, Fred Donald Obrikat on May 9, 1952. The couple was married for 67 years at the time of Fred's death in 2019. Fred and Patsy retired to Siskiyou County 32 years ago, and they ran their small farm outside of Fort Jones since.
