Paul Dee Weddle was at home with family when he passed away on Oct 19th.

Paul was born Nov. 1, 1925 to Laymon and Georgia Weddle in Huntington Park CA and grew up in El Monte CA.

Paul is survived by his wife Neva of 67 years and 2 children, Bill Weddle and Carol Stafford, 11 grandchildren and 12 great grand children.

At 17, Paul volunteered for the Navy in January before his high school graduation in 1944 and served in the Submarine Service as a Machinist Mate 3rd Class. He saw duty in the Pacific area. He was discharged in May 1946.

Paul and Neva were married in the El Monte Methodist Church in 1950. Paul enrolled at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo and completed his degree in Agricultural Science. During that time Paul built their first house in Morro Bay.

After Paul graduated, they moved to Big Springs where he and a partner started a dairy and later, worked for the Ellis Louie Ranch. In 1958 Paul & Neva bought their ranch in Montague.

Paul was a positive influence in many young lives. He began teaching at Horse Creek Elementary followed by 6 years at Montague Elementary and 12

years at Yreka High School in Special Education. He retired from education and spent the next 11 years as owner and operator of Siskiyou Truss Company.

Paul enjoyed being a member of Montague Rotary for 58 years and was active in many community events.

Family and friends will always remember Paul as a man who epitomized all that was good about the greatest generation. He loved his wife and always made sure she and everyone else knew it!!
