



Rachel "Rae" L. Sylva

April 1, 1923 - February 3, 2021

Rachel Sylva, 97 year old Shasta Valley resident, passed away on February 3, 2021 at Fairchild Medical Center in Yreka.

Rae was born in Yreka on April 1, 1923 to Charles and Vivian Fisher of Klamath River. She married Edward Sylva of Willow Creek on July 25, 1944. Rae spent her childhood mostly in the Humbug and Klamath River areas. To attend high school she had to board and room in Yreka as no bus ran in the Humbug area. After graduating from high school in 1941, she worked at Penney's. During World War II she worked at Long Bell Lumber Company in Weed. After her marriage to Ed she moved to the Sylva Brothers Ranch in Willow Creek where she still lived prior to her passing.

Rae was a dedicated ranch wife and loved cooking for the ranch hands. In addition to her love of cooking, flower and vegetable gardening, canning and raising chickens, she was a devoted mother and grandmother. Rae was very active in the Siskiyou County Cattlewomen's Association and Yreka Trail Riders for several years. In 1988 she was named Cattle Woman of the Year. She also loved playing pinochle with her husband and good friends.

Rae is survived by her two daughters, Janet Sylva of Willow Creek and Jeanne (Steve) Burroughs of La Porte, and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She is predeceased by her husband Edward, her two sons

Edward "Wes" Sylva and Stanley Sylva, and her three brothers Marshall Fisher, Pete Fisher, and Les Fisher.
