



## Regis Joseph Pavell

March 5, 1929 - January 2, 2017

Regis Pavell passed away at the Madrone Hospice House in Yreka on January 2, 2017 at the age of 87, after a short battle with cancer.

Regis was born on March 5, 1929 in Whitney, Pennsylvania. He earned his B.S. Degree in Business Administration from St. Vincent College in Latrobe, PA, and served in the U.S. Air Force, stationed in Marysville, CA. He relocated to Southern California, where he worked in the accounting field. He met and married Marcia Ann Henderson in 1960, beginning a journey that would last more than 56 years.
