Richard Ramon Barnes, 60 years old of Yreka, passed away on February 23rd, 2021 at Fairchild Medical Center.

Richard was born on July 22nd, 1960 in Canoga Park, California, to Bonita Groll and Edmund Barnes. He attended Earl Wooster High School in Reno, Nevada. Known by most as "Rick", he moved from Fallon, Nevada to Siskiyou County in 1988. He worked as a sous chef in Nevada casino restaurants, and also in many restaurants in Yreka including El Rancho, Jerry's, Denny's, and most recently at Gold Rush Burgers.
