Richard Graham “Deacon Dick” Enos of Yreka, died on Easter Sunday, April 12, 2020, with his family by his side. Dick was born July 18, 1930 in San Francisco, to John Joseph Enos and Dorothy Graham Enos. Before meeting the love of his life, Janice Bette Ruhland, Dick was a member of the Army Corps of Engineers in Europe from 1952 - 54. In 1957, Dick and Janice married, then raised four children in Mill Valley. They were active members of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel parish. Professionally, Dick was a Civil Engineer who worked for the California Department of Transportation, Bechtel Corporation and as a consultant for Santa Clara County.

Faith in God was of utmost importance to Dick, and he became a Catholic deacon in 1999. After Dick retired from professional work, he and his wife settled in Yreka in 2003. There, Dick was an active member as a deacon of St Joseph’s Catholic parish.

Dick is survived by his wife of 62 years, 4 children, 6 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren and many extended family members and friends that will miss him dearly.
