



## Robert Lincoln Beeson

July 16, 1928 - April 23, 2021

Robert Lincoln "Bob" Beeson, 92, died Friday, April 23, 2021 at Skylark Assisted Living in Ashland, Oregon, after an extended illness.

Bob was born July 16, 1928 in Sebastopol, California, to Arnold and Bessie (Philbrook) Beeson. He grew up in Hoopa before moving to the Fort Jones area, where he married his first wife, Gae Evans in 1951. Together, they had two daughters, Kathleen and Cozette. He lost his first wife, Gae, in 1990, to cancer, after thirty-nine years of marriage. In 2008, he married Maxine Long, and enjoyed ten years of marriage, before losing her to Alzheimer's disease in 2018.

Bob served with the U.S. Army in Korea. After discharge, he worked in logging until taking up carpentry. He built or remodeled dozens of homes in Scott Valley, while also seasonally fighting fires with the U.S. Forest Service.

Bob enjoyed bird hunting with his brother-in-law, Larry; deer hunting with friends and bowling and fishing.

Bob is survived by his two daughters, Kitty (Rick) Kusicko of Priest River, ID and Cozette (Joe) Gastine of St. Maries, ID; two brothers, Bill of Redding and Arnell of Vancouver, WA; one grandchild, Janel (Jeff) Mercer; three great-grandchildren and dozens of nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Gae; second wife, Maxine; three brothers and a sister; brother-in-law and parents.
