



## Robert "Bob" Jack Liskey

June 30, 1937 - November 18, 2015

Longtime Siskiyou County resident, Robert "Bob" Liskey, passed away on Wednesday, November 18, 2015 at the Madrone Hospice House in Yreka. He was 78 years old.

Bob was born on June 30, 1937 to Jack and Veda Liskey in Ashland, Oregon. Bob was a member of the US Army, and married the love of his life, Faybia Pritchett, on August 5, 1968 in Virginia City, Nevada. They have been married since.

Bob was a cattle rancher from the day he was born, and remained a cattle rancher after moving from Maxwell to Siskiyou County in 1976. He was a rancher and a cowboy through and through – his hobbies included horses, cows, roping, and rodeo. In 1965, Bob took 3rd place at the California State Finals Rodeo for team roping. Work and rodeo took second place to one thing in Bob's life: his family. Family always came first, and he took pride in every aspect of his family's lives.
