



Robert Lowell Dalzell

August 14, 1934 - March 19, 2013

Former Weed resident Robert Lowell Dalzell passed away March 19, 2013 in Medford, Oregon. He was 78 years old.

Robert was born August 14, 1934 in Chico to Robert and Maude Dalzell. After he graduated from high school, Robert entered the U. S. Navy during the Korean War and retired from the navy as a Gunners Mate, second class. While in the navy, Robert married Kizuki "Gracie" Ide on April 25, 1962 in Yokohama, Japan. The couple lived in Long Beach before moving to Weed in 1968. Robert worked for the City of Weed for 25 years. He coached Little League and Babe Ruth baseball in Weed for many years.
