Longtime Lake Shastina resident Robert William Day passed away on September 27, 2016. He was 80 years old.

Robert was born on January 19, 1936 in Santa Monica to Arthur and Mildred Day. He was a veteran of the United States Army and served during the Korean Conflict. After he was discharged from the Army, Robert worked for Western Forage and Flange Steel Company in Albany, California, eventually retiring due to health reasons as Vice President of the company.

Robert was a member of the Union of Boilers and Blacksmiths, the Wounded Warriors Project, NRA and Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation. He enjoyed cutting fire wood, hunting, fishing and gardening. He was especially known for his hanging flower baskets. He loved spending time with his grandchildren.

Robert is survived by his longtime partner, Lola Cash of Lake Shastina; a son, Randall Day of Hornbrook; a daughter, Kelsey Scott of Fort Jones; and three grandchildren, Casey Day, Tate Scott and Piper Scott.
