Robert “Rob” Fink passed away at his home in Fort Jones, Ca. on October 23, 2015. He was 48 years old.

Rob Fink was born into a military family in Georgia in 1966, he moved to San Jose, CA at 14 months old. He was schooled in San Jose until 1983. He is survived by his fiancée, Linda Hillebert, mother, Colette Thompson, father, Robert A. Fink, sister, Bonnie Franklin and more than 30 aunts and uncles.
