Robert Harrison "Bob" Smith, 83 year-old, longtime Etna resident, passed away October 2, 2012 in Grenada.

He was born April 8, 1929 in the Red Rock area. He was the 4th of 10 children born to Calvin and Margaret Smith.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving in the Korean Conflict. Bob was a member of Evening Star Lodge #186 F&AM, and a Past Master. He was a member of the Shriners.
