



Robert Foster Killingsworth

January 5, 1935 - December 27, 2020

Longtime Siskiyou County residence, Robert Foster "Bob" Killingsworth, passed away on December 27, 2020 at the Madrone Hospice House in Yreka. He was 85 years old.

Bob was born on January 5, 1935 in Chico, where he grew up as a kid. He attended grade school there. His father was a pro boxer with three other brothers - the first time a set of 4 brothers fought on the same fight card in history was on June 7, 1929. All of the family was very proud of this. Bob's father, Warren, also had a trucking company that carried a contract with PG&E. They moved to Weed in 1949, where Bob attended high school. As a student at WHS, Bob played football, basketball, and ran track; he was a 4 year letterman.

Bob graduated from Weed and went to Shasta College, where he earned a degree in welding. He moved back to Weed and started working at the plywood plant in 1955. He married his first wife, Margret, and they had two children, Terri and Bobby. Bob got a divorce and moved to Yreka in 1967. He went to work for Nor-Cal Products, where he spent 27 years as a welder (and a great one, at that!). Bob was a hunter, and a fishing fool. He kept a chart on how many fish he caught each year. He loved his family and friends; he had some very nice cars, went to a lot of car shows, and won a lot of trophies and plaques. He loved to show off his cars!

Bob had cancer 4 times, and he fought until the end. Godspeed Dad, until we meet again. Bob is in a better place and happy again with his family, including his youngest son, Rick. Bob loved to go have coffee with his friends every morning. He made friends everywhere he went. He was an artist, and many people around Siskiyou County have his art work.

Bob is survived by his two children, Bobby and Terri; six grandchildren, 9 great-grandchildren and a lot of great friends, all of whom he loved very much. Bob will be truly missed. Thank you to all who loved him - he will be looking down on all of you.
