



## Roger Lawhorn Jr.

April 16, 1934 - March 12, 2018

Longtime Siskiyou County resident Roger Lawhorn Jr. passed away on March 12, 2018 at his home in Hornbrook. He was 83 years old.

Roger was born on April 16, 1934 in Chicago, Illinois to Roger and Bertha Lawhorn. He lived most of his life in the San Francisco Bay Area, where he serviced and repaired elevators for the Otis Elevator Company. Roger was very proud of his work for Otis Elevators, even wearing his Otis Elevator watch up to the time of his death. After his retirement, Roger and his wife, Roberta Lawhorn, moved to Siskiyou County, where they lived in the Hornbrook area.

Roger was a longtime member of the Masons and the Elks in both the Bay Area and in Yreka. He was a member of the R-Ranch. Roger loved all of the Bay Area sports teams. He pulled for the Giants, A's, 49ers, Raiders, Warriors and Sharks. Roger was a season ticket holder for the San Francisco 49ers for over 30 years.

Roger is survived by two sons, Jeffrey and Zane Lawhorn; a brother, Ed Lawhorn (Boni); a sister, Margaret Rossini (Geno); five grandchildren and six great grandchildren. Roger was preceded in death by two brothers, John and Leon Lawhorn, and his wife, Roberta, who passed away in 2016.
