Ronald Niels Young, 70 year old long time Siskiyou County resident, passed away at Fairchild Medical Center in Yreka following a short illness.

Ron was born March 20, 1942 in San Francisco to William and Hazel Young and was raised in San Carlos. He and Sharon Fischer were married in 1962. After graduating from Golden Gate College in San Francisco, he went to work for McCormick-Schilling Spices in 1964. He was later transferred to the onion/garlic division in Gilroy as their comptroller. In 1979, he bought Grama's Market in Hornbrook, which he owned for 17 years. After selling the market, he and Sharon worked at Crater Lake Lodge and at Lake Berryessa as work campers. They went on to live in their motor home for 10 years, often visiting areas in Mexico. All the while, Ron continued with his accounting work, including currently working for Dobby's Lock Shop in Yreka.

He was a member of the BPO Elks Lodge for 45 years, including the Yreka #1980 Lodge. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, boating and visiting the R-Ranch. His greatest joy, though, were his 7 year old twin grandsons, Cole and Cale. Ron is survived by his wife, Sharon, of Yreka; his daughter and her husband, Ellice and Tony Cunial of Yreka; his grandsons, Cole and Cale and his sister, Karen Jones, of Tahoe City.
