Russell Marc Harding passed away suddenly in Siskiyou County on September 19, 2015. He was 67 years old.

Marc was born in Portland, Oregon to Logan and Nettie Harding on October 15, 1947. Marc moved to Whittier, California with his family when he was 4 years old. He spent most of his childhood in Whittier before moving to Canyonville, Oregon where he graduated from Canyonville Bible Academy in 1965. Marc and his wife Vonnie met as kids and became childhood buddies; they dated her sophomore year and were married two years later on June 21, 1969.

Marc loved driving trucks, learning from his uncle Raymond and Vonnie's father, Ed; he made a long and successful career of it, driving for over 40 years. He also loved to be outside, whether it was hunting, fishing or in his truck. He loved to read his bible and also enjoyed reading about WWI, WWII and Vietnam and playing an occasional video game. He will be deeply missed by all his family and friends.
