



## Sally Louise Richard

April 15, 1934 - May 17, 2012

Sally Louise Richard, 78, a old long time Siskiyou County resident, passed away on Thursday, May 17, 2012 at her home in Ft. Jones.

Sally was born April 15, 1934, to her parents, Charles and Pauline Whitworth in Berkeley. She was raised there, attending a Catholic school through high school.

After Sally graduated, she joined the U.S. Navy in 1952, where she met her first husband, William Cantrell. They had two daughters together, but sadly, their marriage didn't last.

Sally received her teaching certificate from Sonoma State University in 1966. She taught Kindergarten through Third grade for many years before deciding to retire from teaching.

On March 21, 1964, Sally married Joseph Richard at the Unitarian Church in Berkeley. They resided with their children in Santa Rosa, until they decided to move to Scott Valley in 1968. They knew it was a long shot to start an advertising agency in Fort Jones, but with hard work and a lot of traveling, they turned Joseph Richard Advertising into a thriving business.

Both Sally and Joe gave freely of their time, volunteering at the Ft. Jones Museum, as well as promoting their favorite local politicians' campaigns.

In her younger days, Sally enjoyed bowling, hunting and fishing, even learning to tie her own flies. She collected small animal figurines, particularly owls and frogs. Throughout her life, she was an avid reader. Sally had a passion for all types of jewelry – from finding it at yard sales, to making and/or repairing it for

resale.

Sally is survived by her three daughters, Susan Carswell, Lyn Murray and Sonia Cantrell; 8 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.

A memorial graveside service with military honors will be held at the Northern California Veterans Cemetery in Igo (outside of Redding) at a later date.
