Sigrid Burns Sigrid Burns, long time Scott Valley resident, passed away at her daughter's home in Central Point, Oregon on May 21, 2014 at the age of 93. Sigrid was born in San Francisco, California on November 14, 1920 to Henry and Etta Olson. She lived in San Francisco until the age of 13 when her family moved to Scott Valley to a home on French Creek. She attended elementary school at the Douglas school on French Creek and graduated from the old Etna High School. She met Robert Burns and the two were married on February 11, 1941 and spent 55 happy years together, until Bob's death in March, 1996. Sigrid had many interesting and diverse jobs over her working career. She worked at the ration board in Etna during World War II and at Moffett Field, south of San Francisco, while Bob was serving in the Pacific during the war. At the conclusion of the war, they returned to Scott Valley where they worked on their ranch. Later, she worked for a time as a teacher's aide at Callahan Elementary school, then worked at Charlie's Emporium in Callahan and eventually went to work for the Forest Service in the Callahan and Fort Jones offices, where she worked for over 25 years until her retirement. Sigrid loved to cook, read, and work crossword puzzles but most of all, she love her family and spending time with them. Her favorite time of the year was the holidays where she was able to invite everyone over to their house and cook wonderful dinners.
