December 10, 1944 - April 23, 2017

Steve Lindgren passed away unexpectedly on April 23, 2017 at his home on McAdams Creek in Fort Jones. Steve was born on December 10, 1944 in Glendale, CA to Harry M. Lindgren & Marjorie Reed Lindgren.

Steve attended Fort Jones High School and obtained a bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering from OTI in Klamath Falls. He married Martha Mello at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Fort Jones on August 28, 1970. They were married for 46 years.

Steve enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1962 and served in Cam Ranh Bay, Vietnam. He developed many interests during his life, some of which included flying small airplanes, especially a Volksplane that he built at his home and a Citabria. He also enjoyed restoring classic Fords, including Model T's, a 1956 F-100 pickup and mid-60's Mustangs with his son John. He liked to spend time at his Salmon River cabin and with his German Shepherds & Collie dogs.

After numerous years of working as a Civil Engineer in Siskiyou County, Steve purchased a Log Truck in 1980, and spent the next 25 years as an Owner Operator, offering services with a log dolly, bottom dump, and lowbed trailer.

Steve is survived by his wife Martha; two children, John Lindgren (Devan) of Bakersfield, and Krissi Dias (Jon) of Fort Jones.

He was preceded in death by his infant daughter, Florence Lindgren.

At his request, no funeral services will be held.

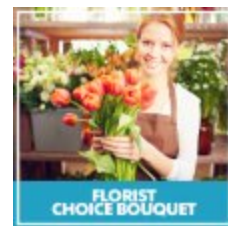
