



## Steven Allen Rose

February 12, 1951 - April 30, 2025

It is with a heavy heart that we announce the passing of our beloved husband, father, and papa. Steve passed away in the comfort of his home surrounded by family after a long and hard-fought battle with cancer at the age of 74 on Wednesday, April 30 at 3:55 p.m.

Steve was born on February 12, 1951 in Yreka at Siskiyou General Hospital on Main Street to Charles Wesley "Pop" and Lillian Belle "Lilly Belle" Snelling Rose. Steve attended Grenada Elementary School, Yreka High School, and his senior year (1969) he graduated from Shasta High School.

In 1970, Steve and his first wife welcomed their daughter, Ginger, into the world, followed by Cinnamon in 1971 and Misty in 1972. In 1981, Steve met and married his wife, Darla, bringing his 3 daughters into the marriage, and Darla bringing her one year old daughter, Kymberly, into their marriage.
