



Thomas Patrick Mallory

August 1, 1931 - May 11, 2015

Longtime Siskiyou County resident, Thomas Patrick Mallory, passed away on Monday, May 11, 2015 at Fairchild Medical Center in Yreka at the age of 83.

Thomas was born on August 1, 1931 in San Francisco to Charles and Margarite Mallory. Charles married the loved of his life, Dorothy Johnson, on March 15, 1953, and the couple was married for 61 years, until Dorothy's death last September.
