Thomas Earl McMahon, 57 year old Siskiyou County native, passed away on Sunday, January 22, 2012 at Mercy Medical Center in Redding. Tom was born January 1, 1955 in Weed to Vernon and Earlene McMahon and was raised in Tulelake, graduating from Tulelake High School.

After being injured in boot camp for the US Army, Tom worked as a bartender. He then went to work as a correctional officer for 20 years, working in California, Wyoming and Montana. He retired to Buffalo and Rawlings Wyoming before moving to Platina to work as a security officer for the R Wild Horse Ranch.

Tom was an avid outdoorsman. He loved to go hunting and fishing. He was also an accomplished artist, working in a full range of mediums, usually depicting wildlife.

Tom is survived by his girlfriend, Kathy Bowers of Platina; 2 sons, Guthrie and Wyatt, both of Sheridan, Wyoming; a brother, Gale McMahon of Malin, Ore.; a sister, Julie Hall of Tulelake; a grandson, Eli and numerous nieces and nephews.
