



Tracy Lloyd Redman

March 1, 1938 - July 9, 2014

Tracy Lloyd Redman, 76 year old long time Yreka resident, passed away at his home on Wednesday, July 9, 2014 following a short illness.

Tracy was born March 1, 1938 in Vera, Oklahoma to Tracy and Dorothy Redman. The family moved to California and Tracy graduated from Summerville Union High School in Tuolumne on June 8, 1956. He served our country in the U.S. Army National Guard and Reserves from March 12, 1956 to March 11, 1964, being discharged as a SSG E-6.

On August 2, 1959, Tracy and Wilma "Margiene" Eby were married in South San Francisco. The couple had two children, Sheila and James, and, in 1975, the family moved to Siskiyou County from South San Francisco. In 1983, Tracy and Margiene and the family opened their home up to a foreign exchange student, Chela, from Peru.

Tracy owned and operated Redman Glass for 37 years. He was a member of the Yreka Volunteer Fire Department from January of 1977 to January of 1997. He was a member of the Yreka Elk's Lodge #1980 for many years and a youth baseball coach for 13 years.

Tracy was preceded in death by Margiene on January 15th of this year. He is survived by his daughter and son-in-law, Sheila and Jeff Vincent; 3 sisters, Ida Roesner of Redding, Mabel Wilets of Sonora and Nadean Williams of Pennsylvania; a brother, Warren Williams of Oklahoma; six grandchildren, Ashley, Rudy and Michael Vincent, Kayla and Zachery Redman and Megan Wade and two great grandchildren, Mason and Jaxson Jones. In addition to

Margiene, Tracy was preceded in death by his son, Jimmy and a sister, Laverna Esparza.
