On May 3, 2022, while walking along the railroad tracks in Woodland, Trey was stuck and killed by a passing train.

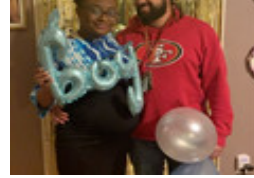
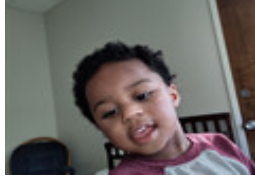
Trey leaves behind his son, Tobias; his Grandma Maggie, and many cousins, aunts, uncles, and friends.
