Tyrone Snow was born to David Loyal “Jake” Snow and Pansy Myrtle Taylor on June 24, 1943, in Oakland, California, and passed away at age 72 on Jan. 10, 2016.

Tyrone enlisted in the Air Force and was stationed in Biloxi, Mississippi, where he met Nancy Elizabeth Tanguis. They were married for 20 years, living in California and Mississippi, and had a daughter and son. He worked as a boiler maker, welder, and roofer until he retired and moved to the mountains in Northern California, where he last lived with his two loving sisters, Betty Jean Bentley and Margie Bentley, in Callahan.

He loved the mountains, hanging out with his friends and family, fishing, taking drives through mountains, and staying for long visits with his children and grandchildren in Mississippi.

He is survived by his daughter, Teresa Nations; his son, Travis “Ty” Snow, and grandchildren, Kadin, Kaitlynn and Brendin Snow; and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother; two brothers, Irving “Tom” and Carl Snow; and two sisters, Doris and Patsy Snow.

A graveside service will be held at 3 p.m. on Friday, Jan. 15, 2016, at the Fort Jones Cemetery in Fort Jones.
