



Valerie "Val" June Vercellotti

June 1, 1940 - February 23, 2021

Longtime Butte Valley resident Valerie June "Val" Vercellotti passed away on February 23, 2021 in Klamath Falls. She was 80 years old.

Val was born on June 1, 1940 in San Francisco to Charlie and Virginia Vannucci. She worked as a stewardess for United Airlines for several years. During that time, she met another United employee, Larry Vercellotti. The couple was married in July of 1961. They lived in the Los Angeles area before moving to San Jose, then moved to the Red Rock area of Macdoel in 1975, where she lived for 40 years. Val managed the Juniper Lodge in Macdoel for several years until it closed. Val owned and operated Diamond V Suffolks, raising and showing sheep for over 35 years. She was also a 4-H sheep leader for 30 years. She enjoyed working with stained glass.

Val is survived by three sons, Bill Vercellotti of Dorris, Jim and Tony Vercellotti, both of Macdoel; five grandchildren and four great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband of 48 years, Larry Vercellotti in 2009 and a sister, Christine Vannucci.
