Vickie Ann (Ahrendt) Douke, born June 23rd, 1948, passed away in Yreka on February 25th, 2022 at the age of 73. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, daughter, aunt, and sister. She was born to Vernon and Virginia Ahrendt in Sioux Falls, South Dakota and grew up on a small farm near the town of Inwood, Iowa. Vickie was the second oldest of seven children. She graduated from Hiram Johnson High School in 1966 and received her BA degree from Sacramento State University in 1971.

She was a preschool teacher for a few years and later began her career with the State of California working for the Department of Agriculture in 1981 and took a position with the Department of Youth Authority in 1983 until she retired in 2003

Vickie enjoyed crafting, sewing, baking, and shopping. She also enjoyed family camping trips, bowling, and hosting pinochle and bunco parties as well as many other family celebrations. Vickie loved reading books and watching her HGTV shows. She knew how to always find the perfect gift for everyone and how to turn a house into a happy home!

She was a devoted Catholic who attended St. Mary's Catholic Church as well as St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church in Sacramento. She joined the parish of St. Joseph's Catholic Church when she and her husband moved to Yreka in 2008. Her faith was a constant in her 15 year battle with metastatic breast cancer.
