



## Vincent Vivier

July 20, 1930 - November 15, 2016

Longtime Siskiyou County resident, Vincent Vivier passed away in Medford, Oregon on November 15, 2016. He was 86 years old.

Vince was born in Devil's Lake, North Dakota on July 20, 1930 to Norman and Zoe Vivier. Vince grew up on a North Dakota farm where they grew wheat and flax, but also raised chickens, turkeys, geese, pigs, and goats. They also had cows and horses. Vince shared one bedroom with 4 siblings, a brother Ted and sisters Stella, Inez, and June. Times were tough and the winters were harsh so the family moved to San Francisco seeking a better future when Vincent was about 11.

Vince was drafted into the Army and sent overseas to Korea where he fought as a machine gunner for 2 years, receiving a Purple Heart and Bronze Star for heroism in ground combat. When he came home he went back to work as a union painter for a short time before getting a job with Hostess bakery where he worked for 36 years. In 1960 he married his wife, Stella and they had 2 children, Vince Jr. and Kirtus. During this time, Vince and the family enjoyed waterskiing, camping, fishing, golfing, bowling, riding motorcycles and traveling. Stella unfortunately passed away in 1982 at the age of 45.

After Vince retired, he moved to a favorite family vacation spot, the R-Ranch. He lived and worked at the R-Ranch for 9 months before finding his

permanent home in Hornbrook. Vince attended the local church where he met his wife Ada Dodd. Vince and Ada were married in 1991 and enjoyed traveling, gardening, and were active with the local community church. And yes, he still loved golfing with friends.

Vince is survived by his wife, Ada Vivier; sons, Vince Vivier Jr. and Kirtus Vivier and granddaughter, Madison Vivier.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, December 10, 2016 at 11:00 am at the Hornbrook Community Bible Church, 430 Henley Hornbrook Rd, Hornbrook, CA.

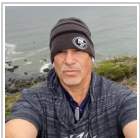

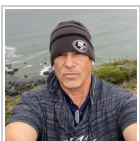
