



## Virgil Frank Rossetto

November 24, 1925 - December 8, 2010

Lifelong Weed resident Virgil Frank Rossetto passed away December 8, 2010 at Shasta View Nursing Center in Weed. He was 85 years old.

Virgil was born November 24, 1925 in Weed to Quinto and Lucia Rossetto. He graduated from Weed High School, and served in the U.S. Army in the Philippines and Okinawa during World War II. After the war, he returned to Weed, where he worked at the Long Bell and International Paper mills. Virgil married Zoe Favero in 1951.

Virgil was a member of the Holy Family Catholic Church in Weed. He loved fishing, gardening and spending time with his grandchildren. There wasn't a lake in Siskiyou County that he had not fished in.

Virgil is survived by his wife of 59 years, Zoe; a daughter, Paula Rossetto of Sacramento; a brother, Fred Rossetto and his wife Olga of Mount Shasta; a sister, Mary Lombardi of Mount Shasta; two grandchildren, Meagan Smith and her husband Tony, and Eric Rossetto; and Mikie and Tom Mulvihill along with numerous nieces and nephews. Virgil was preceded in death by his son, Dale Rossetto in 1986.
