



Virginia Irene Milne

September 26, 1931 - November 12, 2019

Lifelong Yreka resident, Virginia Irene Milne, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, November 12th, 2019 at the Madrone Hospice House. She was 88 years old.

Virginia was born in Yreka on September 26th, 1931 to John and Agnes Skeahan, both of whom were also Siskiyou County natives. Virginia married William “Bill” Milne on September 23rd, 1950, and celebrated 57 years of bliss with him until his death in 2007.

Virginia worked at Yreka General Hospital, and later Fairchild Medical Center, for a total of 41 years. The majority of that time was spent in food services, a position she dearly loved and in which she earned merit for her longevity. Outside of her work at the hospital, Virginia was an avid gardener and a shopping extraordinaire, as evidenced by how she loved to spoil others with gifts. Her favorite pastime was her children and grandchildren. She was known to never miss a sporting event of theirs, and she valued her family above all else.

Virginia also enjoyed cooking, gambling, and travelling – usually trying to make one large trip each year to destinations such as Alaska, Tennessee, Europe, and Florida. She even took her extend family on a cruise to Mexico. She was a huge San Francisco Giants fan through the years of highs and

lows, and was thrilled to see their 3 championship seasons recently.

Virginia was preceded in death by her husband, Bill, her son, Bill Jr. in 1996, and her son, Kevin, who passed away shortly after birth. She is survived by her daughter Cheryl Miller, of Yreka, 4 grandchildren, 8 great-grandchildren, and by many extended family, friends, and co-workers.

No immediate services are planned for Virginia. Her cremated remains will be laid to rest with her husband and son in Evergreen Cemetery. A celebration of her life will be planned at a later date for family and friends to gather and remember what a special woman she was.
