



Waldo William Lorenzini

January 6, 1939 - July 23, 2018

Lifelong Siskiyou County resident Waldo William Lorenzini passed away unexpectedly on July 23, 2018 at his home in Montague. He was 79 years old.

Waldo was born in Yreka on January 6, 1939 to Cesare and Olga Lorenzini. He graduated from Yreka High School, and lived on his ranch near Yreka. He worked for many years at Timber Products as a loader operator, along with running his cattle and hay ranch. He was a member of BPOE Elks Lodge #1810 in Yreka, the Sons of Italy in Weed, and was a longtime board member of the Shasta River Water District. He was funny, but very caring.

Waldo is survived by a son, Arthur Lorenzini; three stepchildren, Susie Mead, and Mike and Tom Morgan; a sister, Josephine Rennick, and many nieces and nephews. Waldo was preceded in death by his first wife, Rose Lorenzini, in 1982, and his second wife, Raylene Lorenzini in 2011.

A graveside service will be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018 at 2:00 PM at Evergreen Cemetery in Yreka.
