His favorite past-time was hunting - whether big game or upland bird, varmints or turkey - and he enjoyed making his own arrows for use during archery season. Additionally, there wasn't a bass pond in the county that Walker wasn't familiar with.

Walker was a very open and honest person. He told it like it was, never in mean or condescending way; rather, from a place of care and concern. He was the type of person that could be approached by anyone for a problem or issue, and he would offer his no-nonsense, practical, and blunt assessment. Walker was always up for an adventure, and he shared in many with his close friends. He was always on the go, well aware of the fact that memories aren't made by sitting idle. While his memory will live on, his friends will have to endure future endeavors with an emptiness in their group.
