



Wesley Owen Morgan

December 3, 1930 - February 21, 2016

Wesley Owen Morgan passed away on Sunday, February 21, 2016 at his home in Horse Creek, California. Nine of his eleven children and some friends were present when he passed. He was preceded in death by his wife, Carrie Morgan; parents, Wesley Eugene Morgan and Ila Mae Owen Morgan, as well as his brothers, Ernie Morgan and Deskin "Red" Morgan; sisters, Jackie Morgan and Ruby Purdin; and a grandson, Jason Morgan.

Wes is survived by his brother, Herman Morgan; first wife, Bessie Wiley Morgan; second wife, Sylvia May Morgan; his children: Marcia Morgan, Wesley "Wiley" Morgan, Joyce Haney, Wendy Callick, Cindy Lucas, David Callick, Tracy Callick, Trudy Rainey, Sean Morgan, Scott Morgan, and James Morgan; as well as many grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Wes was born in El Segundo, California on December 3, 1930. The Great Depression was hard on his family, but he worked his way through school and eventually achieved a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology from LA State. After college, he had varying careers from construction to teaching and surveying cotton to raising chickens. He was in the Navy Reserve during the Korean War. He served 30 years on the Klamath River Fire Department and was voted Fire Fighter of the Year twice, but the career that was most important to him was his family.

Wes was best known for his kindness and generosity, always willing to lend a hand and never wanting anything in return.

A memorial for Wesley Owen Morgan will be held at the Horse Creek Community Church on February 27, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. with a potluck to follow. Instead of flowers, it would be fitting to perform a random act of kindness in Wes' memory.
